

## Directions to Casa Blanca

### From San Diego Airport to U.S./Tijuana Border

1. Coming out of Terminal, follow signs to Interstate 5.
2. You will be on Harbor Drive (road along the water), until you reach Grape St. (Turn left)
3. Go up hill for about 4 blocks until you see the sign for Interstate 5 South.
4. Get on the I-5 heading south, you will be on the highway for about 20 minutes until you reach the Mexican border.

### Directions: U.S./Tijuana Border to Ensenada

1. Upon arriving to the border, you will come to a stop where you will be given a green or red light. If you get a green light, go through, if you get a red light, go to the customs officer on the far right and they will instruct you further.
2. As you go straight, follow the signs that indicate "ENSENADA (SCENIC ROAD)" on your immediate right – **Note:** Be very careful because the signs do not give you very much time to react. Slow down and take your time. *You don't want to get lost in Tijuana.*
3. Follow all the signs to "ENSENADA (SCENIC ROAD)". You will pass through 3 toll booths (approx. 50 minutes driving until you reach the 3<sup>rd</sup> one). At the 3<sup>rd</sup> toll booth, you are at the entrance of Ensenada.
4. As you pass through the 3<sup>rd</sup> toll booth, stay in the right lane. The road will split in two. You need to be in the lane that veers to the right and will be taken through the tourist road of Ensenada, along the coast.



5. You will pass through the congested tourist section. (See map above for reference – getting through Ensenada). As you do so, you will pass the huge Mexican flag (on your right, on the water side). If the flag is not up, the flag pole will be there (it's huge, you can't miss it). Pass the flag pole FIRST and then look for a **PEMEX** gas station on your left, where there is also a stop light. **Turn left** at the light. (We cannot rely on street signs or names)
6. Go straight on this road until you reach the "**Soriana**" superstore which will be on the right hand side/corner (shopping center) there will be a stop light. **Turn right**. Continue on this road...There will also be a main street sign leading you to "1" and "La Bufadora"
7. **To "La Bufadora"**: You will travel on this road for about 20 minutes until you see the sign for "LA BUFADORA". The sign will indicate to turn right again, slow down because the sign is at the exit. Turn right. Follow the road you turned onto and do not get off at any exits. This road will take you through several little "communities" (Cantu, Campo La Jolla). You continue on this road along the coast line going towards La Bufadora. The road winds up the mountain side and when you come to the top and can see water on both sides look for a bright yellow building with a gate out front on your right side. Turn right here you will see signs that say Casa Blanca and Campo Siete (camp 7). If the gate is open drive through, if not or if you get stopped just state you are going to Casa Blanca and they will let you through. Continue up the dirt road, you will cross over a road coming down the mountain on your left. As you cross the road you will see the white wall surrounding Casa Blanca. Please park outside the gate on your left and walk in through the gate. It will take you approximately 20 minutes to get there after you turn off of the main road.
